

1. CIL ended April-June quarter FY'23 capping a historic high of 29% output growth, compared to same quarter FY'22. CIL produced 152.49 million tonnes (MTs) of coal as of Q1 end, which is 35.8 MTs more than the 124 MT output of April-June'22. CIL's first quarter production surge of nearly 36 MTs surpassed the entire annual increase of 26.4 MTs of FY'22.

2. Earlier, the coal ministry had issued a draft Cabinet note to sell 25 percent of Coal India's consulting unit, CMPDI and BCCL to the public. 3. As per the records, Coal-based power generation increased by 26.58% to 95,880 million units in June. The overall power generation in June 2022 has been 17.73% higher than the power generated in June 2021. However, total power generation also dipped by 0.76% to 1,38,995 MU in June from 1,40,059 MU in May.

4. At least 12 more new mines will start production during the year. Currently, a total of 36 captive and commercial mines are under production. The Coal Ministry is hopeful that the target production of 32 million tonnes from coal blocks during the second quarter of FY 2022-23 will be achieved.

5. India imported over 25 million tonnes of thermal coal and coking coal in June, rising by over a third compared with the same period last year. Imports of thermal coal jumped to 40% amounting to 19.6 million tonnes, while shipments of coking coal surged 23% totaling to about 5.4 million tonnes. The energy-hungry nation's annual power demand is growing at the fastest rate in at least 38 years and high global coal prices, amid the Russia-Ukraine crisis, are straining the finances of debt-laden government-run utilities.

6. Coal shortages at various power generation companies (gencos) had impacted the electricity supply in the country during the peak summer months of April and May. To ensure adequate supply of coal, CIL has given the contract to PT Bara Daya Energy consortium to import 7.91 lakh tonnes of coal for supplying to gencos during August and September.

8. To ensure adequate supply of coal to various sectors, including power, the government has set a target of one billion tonnes coal production for CIL by FY 2024-25. To achieve this target, from April 2020 to June 2022, environmental clearance granted to 60 proposals in the Stage-I, 14 proposals in Stage-II and 53 project reports including expansion projects have also been approved by CIL.

9. Global coal-fired electricity generators are producing more power than ever before in response to booming electricity demand and the surging price of gas. The world's coal-fired generators produced a record 10,244 terawatt-hours (TWh) in 2021 surpassing the previous record of 10,098 TWh set in 2018. Coal-fuelled generation is on course to set an even higher record in 2022 as generators in Europe and Asia minimise the use of expensive gas following Russia's invasion of Ukraine and U.S. and EU sanctions imposed in response.

10. India has firmed up a plan to import around 76 million tonnes (mt) of coal to help plug a fossil fuel shortfall at its power plants in the current financial year. This in turn may result in an increase in electricity tariffs by 50-80 paise per unit depending on the distance of the power stations from seaports. With the monsoon expected to affect India's coal production and supplies to power plants in August and September, CIL will import 15 mt to supply to power stations.

12. The Coal Ministry has terminated mining leases of WBPDCCL, MIEL and NTPC for delays in operationalising coal blocks and missing production targets. Mine termination orders have also been slapped on GMR Chhattisgarh Energy, and OCL Iron and Steel with both orders being sub-judice. With this a total of 45 companies have been penalized.

State government-run power generating companies (Gencos) from Maharashtra, Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Karnataka have approached the Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) to avail working capital loans amounting to Rs. 3,700 crore for procuring coal, the Parliament was informed. The Maharashtra State Power Generation Company (MSPGCL) approached for a working capital loan of Rs. 1,800 crore alone. RRVUNL, HPGCL and KPCL approached for Rs. 500 crore each whereas PSPCL has approached for a loan of Rs. 400 crore.

14. Decommissioning of coal power plants that are more than 25 years old could lead to a potential savings of Rs 37,750 crore, indicated a study by the Council on Energy, Environment and Water-Centre for Energy Finance (CEEW-CEF). The report also said that out of India's total installed capacity of 300 Gw, some 35 Gw of coal-based power plants can be decommissioned on priority.

According to National Steel Policy 2017, to achieve steel-making capacity of 300 MTPA (including 180 MTPA through Blast Furnace route) by 2030, approximately 170 million tonnes (MT) coking coal will be required by 2030. Government has launched Coking Coal Mission to meet this demand of domestic coking coal and has set 105 MT of coking coal production target for CIL and 35 MT for others including allocated coking blocks, by 2030. To achieve the above target, the Government has taken steps to explore new coking coal blocks, auction of new coking coal mines, enhancing raw coking coal production and enhancing coking coal washing capacity including few other steps.
